Aims and Objectives	<p>The aim of the course "Political System of Kosovo 2" is to provide students with knowledge on the political system of the state of Kosovo. The course will cover: the historical context of the state formation of Kosovo, focusing on the main events that have influenced this process; institutional architecture, focusing on the legislature, the executive and the judiciary; political parties, aspects of the electoral system; the state of Kosovo in the framework of Euro-integration processes as well as the political system of Kosovo in the regional context.</p> <p>The main aim of the course "Kosovo Political System 2" is to provide detailed knowledge of how Kosovo institutions interact in formulating Kosovo policies. With the course syllabus we aim to highlight the historical constitutional aspect, the institutional architecture as well as the political system within the Euro-integration processes.</p>
